

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF ALL TRAFFIC, DRIVING, WAITING AND ONE  
WAY)**

**ORDER EVENTS/2023/REMEMBRANCE**

Whereas Cambridgeshire County Council ("the Council") being the traffic authority for various locations in the various Parishes and Towns described is satisfied that all traffic should be restricted by reason of relevant events proposed to be held on or adjacent to the roads. The Schedule of roads that this Order applies will be available at <https://www.cambridgeshire.gov.uk/residents/travel-roads-and-parking/roads-and-pathways/highway-events/> no later than 27/10/2023

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by The Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 12<sup>th</sup> November 2023 for 1 day and may be cited as **CAMBRIDGESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS LOCATIONS: REMEMBRANCE PARADES AND SERVICES) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF ALL TRAFFIC, DRIVING, WAITING AND ONE WAY) ORDER EVENTS/2023/REMEMBRANCE**
2. It is anticipated that this order will only apply at the locations, date and times specified on the Schedule of roads.
3. While the Order is in operation no person shall cause or permit any vehicular traffic/cyclists/equestrians to proceed in any direction over the roads described in Schedule 1 to this Order other than any vehicle/cyclists/equestrians connected to the relevant event.
- 3.1 No person shall cause any vehicle to wait in or upon any road described in Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. Nothing in this Order shall prevent pedestrian access and egress from premises or land adjacent to the roads as mentioned in the Schedules attached.

Nothing in this Order shall apply so as to prevent the passage of any vehicle being used by any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service, a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer.
